

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: What are the dates for the Bar-B-Que, rodeo, parade and Go Texan Day?
A: World's Championship Bar-B-Que Contest: Thursday – Saturday, Feb. 25-27, 2010,
Go Texan Day: Friday, Feb. 26, 2010,
Downtown Parade and ConocoPhillips Rodeo Run: Saturday, Feb. 27, and
Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™: March 2-21, 2010.
- Q: Should I just wait to buy my Bar-B-Que admission ticket at the gate?
A: If you buy a Reliant Park Admission Ticket before going to the World's
Championship Bar-B-Que Contest, you save \$3 per adult and \$1 per child. You can
also avoid potentially standing in an admission ticket purchase line at the gate.
- Q: What is the deadline to purchase Half-Price Carnival Packs and admission tickets?
A: Mail orders must be postmarked by Wed., Feb. 17, 2010, and
Internet, phone and fax orders are accepted through Fri., Feb. 26, 2010.
- Q: Do I need a Reliant Park Admission Ticket if I have a concert ticket?
A: No. RodeoHouston™ concert tickets include admission to the carnival, livestock
show, horse shows, food and shopping in Reliant Center.
- Q: Does the Season Pass include admission to the Bar-B-Que?
A: Yes. The Season Pass allows unlimited admission to the World's Championship Bar-
B-Que Contest, carnival, livestock show, horse shows, food and shopping in Reliant
Center. It does not allow admission to Reliant Stadium or Rodeo Uncorked! events.
- Q: Is the Season Pass good for carnival rides and games?
A: No. It is valid for admission, not carnival rides and games.
- Q: How many tickets does it take for each ride or game?
A: Each ride requires between 3 to 12 tickets and each game requires a minimum of 6
tickets.
- Q: Why is there a handling fee?
A: Tickets are packaged and mailed directly from the Houston Livestock Show and
Rodeo™. You may combine orders and have them sent to one mailing address.
- Q: Can I forward this flyer to friends and family?
A: We encourage you to pass on this great savings opportunity!
- Q: What is a carnival charity donation?
A: The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™ uses these donations to send ill and
underprivileged children to the carnival and livestock show. All recipients are non-
profit 501(c)(3) organizations. Just \$15 allows a child go to the carnival to enjoy a
few rides and games. Every dollar helps!
